## Information For Woodward Parents and Students

Welcome to the Woodward Learning Community! Whether you are a returning student or a new student, this is going to be a WONDERFUL year. We hope that you are rested and ready to go. Below is some information for you that explains the first day and week of school.

## TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER $5^{\text {TH }}$.

All new and returning students from last year will attend from 8:45am 9:45am. If you are a returning student from last year, you will line up at the same doors that were used for class entry: Division 6, Door \#1, the front door, Division 5 and Division 4 Door \#4, Division 3, Door \#6, Divisions 1 \& 2, Door \#8.

If you are a new student to Woodward, line up at Door \#1, the front door at $8: 40 \mathrm{am}$ and your attendance will be taken in the library, and you will be placed in a grade grouping for the week. Signs will be placed on the exterior doors.

Parents are welcome and invited to gather in the gym for this hour. At approximately 9:15 all students will move to the gym for our welcome back assembly. Dismissal is at 9:45am.
