THE "OCEAN-WISE SEA DOME" EXPERIENCE COMES TO WOODWARD FRIDAY DECEMBER 15TH



We are excited to welcome the Ocean Dome mobile program, which feature marine artifacts and hands-on interactive activities designed to encourage passion and care of our oceans and waterways, to our school this Friday.

Their team of educators will be at Woodward all day to deliver expert level, multi-sensory aquatic programs, based on the Ocean Literacy Framework to all of our students from K to Grade 7.

Ocean Dome instructors strive to create a lasting connection to our oceans and aquatic habitats by encouraging direct conservation action. The Ocean Wise Sea Dome is a new immersive ocean adventure that brings marine magic to communities everywhere. The portable, inflatable six-metre dome projects 360-degree 4K cinematic footage showing connections between ocean health, climate change, and daily life.

Woodward students will have the chance to see the Arctic, to view changes in sea ice, to view tropical reefs to assess impacts of ocean acidification, and to explore BC's rivers to learn how salmon habitats can be preserved.
